Victoria, Seychelles, 07 August 2019– At the sidelines of his presentation of credentials, Ambassador Alex G. Commissioner Labonte, on the other hand, lauded the good behavior of the Filipino Community in Seychelles and expressed that they were a credit to the Philippines. He further stated that of the migrant communities in Seychelles, Filipinos were the best and has enhanced the Seychelles society.
