Kigali, 17 August 2019 – The Philippine Embassy in Nairobi, Kenya conducted its annual Consular Mission in Kigali, Rwanda on 17 August 2019 at the Urban by City Blue Hotel in Kigali, Rwanda.

The Consular Team, composed of Consul General Edgar Tomas Q. Auxilian and Protocol Officer Jake E. Fernandez, provided passport renewal, certification and document authentication services as well as consultation services. The team was able to serve twenty five (25) Overseas Filipinos in Kigali, Rwanda.

The Team also ascertained the current situation of Filipinos in Rwanda, especially on the issue of the Ebola Virus Outbreak. Rwanda shares a border with the Democratic Republic of the Congo, which is currently facing a deadly outbreak of the Ebola Virus. The outbreak, which began in March 2019, has already claimed over One Thousand (1,000) lives in the affected country.

The Overseas Filipinos in Rwanda, which number over fifty (50) are composed mostly of working professionals, some involved in various engineering and technical projects, as well as medical professionals involved in dentistry. Some Filipinos also work in restaurants and hotels and some also work for United Nations agencies and other International Organizations.

The Consular Mission highlights the Embassy's commitment to reach out to all Overseas Filipinos in its jurisdiction in East Africa. (End)
