Nairobi – The Philippine Permanent Representative to the United Nations Human Settlements Programme (UN-Habitat) met with the UN-Habitat Executive Director Maimunah Mohd Sharif during an event hosted by the Dean of the Diplomatic Corps in Nairobi on 28 June 2019.

Recently, it held the 1st UN-Habitat Assembly on 27-31 May 2019 with delegations from 127 countries including four Heads of State and Government and 49 ministers out of the 2,900 delegates in attendance.
