PUBLIC ADVISORY NO. 2021-49

SUBJECT: IATF Resolution No. 151-A, Series of 2021

DATE: 02 December 2021

The Philippine Embassy in Nairobi informs the public, in accordance with Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF) Resolution Number 151-A, series of 2021, of the following testing and quarantine protocols for all inbound passengers effective until **15 December 2021**:

I. The protocols for inbound passengers from "Green List" and "Yellow list" countries/jurisdictions/territories in all ports of entry in the Philippines shall be as follows:

For Fully Vaccinated Individuals:		
A.	With Negative RT-PCR Test taken within seventy-two (72) hours prior to departure from the country of origin	Facility-based quarantine until the release of negative RT-PCR test taken on the 3rd day; and
		14-day self-monitoring for any symptoms, with the first day being the date of arrival
В.	Without Negative RT-PCR Test pre- departure test	Facility-based quarantine until the release of negative RT-PCR test taken on the 5th day; and
		Home quarantine until the 10th day, with the first day being the date of arrival

For unvaccinated, partially vaccinated, or individuals whose vaccination status cannot be independently validated:

Facility-based quarantine until the release of negative RT-PCR test taken on the 7th day; and Home quarantine until the 14th day with the first day being the date of arrival

II. The inbound international travel of all persons, regardless of vaccination status, coming from or who have been to "Red List" countries/jurisdictions/territories within the last fourteen (14) days prior to arrival to any port of the Philippines **shall not be allowed.** Only Filipinos returning to the country via government-initiated repatriation, and *Bayanihan* Flights may be allowed entry subject to the prevailing entry, testing, and quarantine protocols for "Red List" countries/jurisdictions/territories.

III. Visa-free entry for all foreign nationals remains suspended, and guidelines and procedures on visa and entry exemption document (EED) issuance prior IATF-Resolution 150-A remain in force.
