## PUBLIC ADVISORY NO. 2022-41

## SUBJECT : Resumption of Continuing Overseas Voter Registration (09 December 2022 – 30 September 2024)

## DATE : 28 November 2022

All qualified Filipino citizens who are not registered overseas voters may file their applications for registration at the Embassy pursuant to COMELEC Resolution No. 10833 from **09 December 2022 to 30 September 2024.** 

To register, applicants must <u>personally</u> submit the accomplished <u>Overseas</u> <u>Voter Registration Form (OVF1)</u> to the Embassy and present the following requirements:

- 1. Valid Philippine Passport;
- 2. In the absence of a valid Passport:
  - a. A Certification issued by the Post that it has received and reviewed the appropriate documents submitted by the applicant and found them sufficient to warrant the issuance of a passport, or that the applicant is a holder of a valid passport but is unable to produce the same for a valid reason;
  - b. In case of applicants who reacquired their Filipino citizenship pursuant to Republic Act No. 9225, the original or certified true copy of the Order of Approval of their application to retain or reacquire their Filipino citizenship issued by Post or their Identification Certificates issued by the Posts or the Bureau of Immigration; or
  - c. In case of seafarers, photocopy of Seafarer's Book.

The Embassy is open for the filing of registration from Mondays to Fridays (excluding holidays), 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM.
