The public is advised that effective **05 December 2022**, all travelers to the Philippines, including returning residents, will be required to provide their travel information and health declaration through the **eTravel portal** (https://etravel.gov.ph).

With the launch of the new platform, the One Health Pass is no longer required, and its related system will no longer be accessible. The Philippine Bureau of Immigration will also discontinue using the paper arrival card.
